**Regular City Council Meeting**

Thursday August 9, 2018

The mayor Scott Marolf called the City Council meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. Roll call was taken by Mickey Dalin. In attendance were Council Members: Terry Lee, Tyler Ballard by phone and Doug Hoskinson. John Pine was absent. Audience members in attendance were Bonnie and Ken Cox and Anthony Conti representing Crestline Engineers.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**A: Donation Request American Legion Golf Scramble-Action Item** Mickey asked the council if the council wanted to donate to the American Legion golf Scramble as in years past. **Councilmember Doug Hoskinson motioned to donate 50.00 to the American Legion Golf Scramble Second by Council President Terry Lee motion passes 3-0.**

**B: Transfer of Alcohol License-Action Item** The Mayor Scott Marolf recused himself from discussion. Council President Terry Lee explained that Camas Creek Country Store has sold to Scott Marolf and the alcohol license need transferred into his name and the fees have been paid. **Councilmember Doug Hoskinson motioned to transfer license from Barbara Cutler to Scott Marolf Second by Tyler Ballard motion carries 3-0.**

**C: Fence Ken Cox-ACTION ITEM-** Ken Cox explained that on the edge of town there is approximately 74 acres of undeveloped land. He and Jay Caven are looking for a way to keep the subdivision from flooding. Also, they talked about the fire hazard. Ken explained that Jay Caven said they would fence the area and let Ken Cox graze it. Ken swathed a path on the edge of property. Ken would like to propose 3 sections of the property: first section would be a non-permanent section by the LDS church, second piece would be west over by John Graybill's house the third section would be north over by the new park clear to Robbie Miller's house. Ken is willing to get a permit to put the fence in the way he explained. Terry Lee spoke and asked what kind of livestock would be put out there. Ken answered it would be horses. Terry wanted a clarification on the ordinance. Natalie explained there is not an agricultural zone in the City of Fairfield it is residential. Livestock is not allowed in town. Ken interpreted the ordinance differently. Councilmember Doug Hoskinson asked how many horses. Ken answered 12-15. Council President Terry Lee asked if it would be a concern about the kids being in the pasture. Ken answered that they could not see a

problem. Councilmember Tyler Ballard spoke about the primary concern was that kids would get in the fence. He also stated that it is getting late in the year it would only be used for a short time. Ken stated that the pasture would not probably get used this year the fence would be put up. Council President Terry Lee would like a clarification from the attorney on the ordinance. Natalie stated the fence needs approved through Planning and Zoning. Ken was instructed to apply for a fence permit. This will be discussed at the August 16th meeting.
